The 2007 airshow season has been very exciting for us. Our F-86 Sabre has been warmly received at airshows all summer long. In June, we were honored to be asked by the Air Force Materiel Command to bring the Sabre to Wright-Patterson AFB to participate in their 60th anniversary airshow.

The next weekend the Sabre appeared at the Battle Creek airshow, where the Hoppers flew as the opening act on both Saturday and Sunday. The Hoppers received many compliments on their L-39 routine. In July, the Sabre flew at "Thunder over Michigan", AirVenture 2007 at Oshkosh, and the Selfridge Air Show in Michigan.
